Pool Rules

- 1. The pool will open Saturday of Memorial Day weekend and close Labor Day, subject to change at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- 2. The pool will be opened Monday through Sunday at 10:00 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m.
- 3. Use of the pool and recreation facility will be restricted to homeowners and their guests. Guests and children must be accompanied by a homeowner at all times.
- 4. When there is one person in the pool, there must be another adult on deck.
- 5. No diving or jumping into the pool.
- 6. Floats, balls or toys are not permitted in the pool.
- 7. The Suffolk County Department of Health Services recommends that swim diapers be worn by bathers who are incontinent, lack toilet training, or are otherwise lacking voluntary control of excretory functions.
- 8. No person will make unnecessary noise or behave in any objectionable manner in the pool or recreation area.
- 9. The Suffolk County Department of Health requires that bathers shower prior to entering the pool. Showers are provided in the clubhouse.
- 10.Homeowners will be held responsible for all actions of their guests in the pool area and clubhouse.
- 11.Pollution of the swimming pool is prohibited. Urinating, expectorating or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
- 12.**Communicable disease.** No person having skin lesions, sore or inflamed eyes, mouth, nose or ear discharge may use the pool.

- 13.Food and beverages are not permitted in the pool area, except water in plastic containers.
- 14. To avoid accidents, shoes must be worn at all times in the clubhouse. Do not enter the clubhouse with dripping bathing suits.
- 15.No towels or articles of clothing may be hung over the fence.
- 16.First Aid supplies are available at the double-door entrance to the clubhouse while the pool is open.
- 17.All additional regulations required now or in the future by the Suffolk County Department of Health shall be obeyed by all members and their guests.
