Please have clients call ahead to sites to confirm the Advocate will be there and to find out if there are any safety protocols in place.

Senior Advocates will educate seniors on benefits they may be eligible for and assist them in applying for those benefits. Particular emphasis is on programs that foster economic independence such as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP- formerly known as Food Stamps), Medicare Savings Program (MSP), and HEAP.
